VISION

God's offspring Home is the rehabilitation centre of the Wholistic Outreach an arm of the Redeemed Christian Church of God is established to:

- ≠ Give hope, love, care and support to those who hitherto were living in hotels and prostituting under the bridge, the neglected and stranded teenagers.
- ≠ To attend to the spiritual, physical, emotional and psychological needs of the said above.
- ≠ To provide adequate vocational training for them to make them productive citizens of the society.
- ≠ To make them a disciple of Jesus Christ.

Introduction

God's Offspring Home is the rehabilitation centre of the Wholistic Outreach a ministry under The Redeemed Christian Church of God. The president of the Project is Pastor (Mrs) Folu Adeboye. It was established in September, 2003 to give hope, love, care and support to girls who hitherto were living in hotels and those that were stranded. It is an institution for teenagers and young ladies between the ages of 14 - 30 years.

The home comprises of three centers;

- (1) Main home- Loburo village, Ogun State
- (2) Main home - Port Harcourt, River State

The two homes are situated in a quite environment conducive for learning and spiritual growth.

Goals and Objectives

- Disciple the girls to follow Jesus Christ
- Give them various skill acquisition opportunities
- Provide education
- Give them Biblical Counseling for spiritual reformation

Target

The home is open to teenage girls and young ladies who have made up their minds to depart from their old ways of sinful living such as:

- Stranded teenage girls
- Young people in commercial sex work
- Stranded and helpless teenage girls

They must be between the ages of 14 - 30 years.

Curriculum

- Catering
- Hair dressing
- Computer training
- Fashion designing/ Dress Making
- Adult education
- Discipleship training.
- Drama/Music
- Photography
- Hats and Textile Designing

Admission Process

Duration of Programme

The duration for rehabilitation in the home is 12-24 months depending on the spiritual growth of the daughter. The management however reserves the right to determine when a daughter graduates as led by the Holy Spirit.

This is divided into three (3) phases

- 1-3 months mainly discipleship lessons/deliverances
- 4th month reconciliation of daughters to her family
- 5th-12th month vocational training/schooling (discipleship lesson still continues)
- 18th-24th month graduation (depending on the spiritual growth).

Application forms can be collected from the Home/Administrative office at a fee.

Sponsorship

The applicants after admission are to be supported by the sending church/organization or individuals during their stay in the home. The sponsor will be responsible for;

- Monthly upkeep (subsidized by ministry) while in the home
- Cost of vocational training/schooling
- Settlement after training

Calendar

Admission to the home is done two (2) times a year

- January to March (1st set)
- July to September (2nd set)

Visitation

- Family 2nd Saturday of the month
- Church/organization 3rd Saturday of the month

Uniform/Housewears

The wearing of uniform and house wears are compulsory both for classes and home. Details will be given on admission of the daughters.

Health

There is a well equipped First aid box in the home to cater for minor ailments. However serious ailments are referred to hospitals and sponsors will be responsible for the charges.

Note: Applicant must bring full medical/HIV reports from a designated laboratory before admission.

Discipline

The management team through the Home Administrator shall be responsible for discipline and reserves the right to suspend or expel any daughter guilty of behaviour prejudicial to the smooth running of the home.

NO DISOBEDIENCE TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE HOME

NO FIGTHING OR USE OF ABUSIVE LANGUAGES
